With this type of project, the Everhart nurtures creativity and showcases artistic excellence in the community. DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS ONLY.

### ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all residents in northeastern Pennsylvania.

### DIRECTIVE:

Take or share a photo or snapshot that features the Everhart Museum building in some way. Originality is key, so please be creative!

ENTRY RULES:

- 1) Work will only be accepted in the following media: digital photography. Historic or print photos should be converted (scanned) to digital formats. No other type of media or materials (painting, drawing, 3-D) will be accepted. Each artist will be limited to ten (10) submissions.
- 2) Entry dimensions must be no greater than 11" x 14" in size, and ideally resolution should be 300 dpi. All entries are to be emailed to the curator at the email address below. The Everhart Museum will then print the selected images for exhibition.
- 3) Entrants will not be permitted to take photos inside the Everhart Museum in galleries prohibiting photography.
- 4) COMPLETE entry form/ID tag must be submitted along with the digital photo for consideration. Work submitted without a complete entry form will not be considered for exhibition. Each entry must have its own entry form.
- 5) All digital entries must be submitted to the Everhart Museum office, by email or on digital drives, located through the rear entrance of 1901 Mulberry Street, Scranton, PA 18510, between 11 am and 4 pm on 4 December 2015. Work may also be submitted via email, postmarked by the 4 December deadline.
- 6) All work submitted will be subject to a juried competition for inclusion in the final show. Submitting a work does not guarantee that it will appear in the show. Works will not be for sale.
- 7) The Everhart Museum reserves the right to use all submissions for promotional and marketing purposes, including but not limited to print, website, and social media.

#### ENTRY FEE: There is no entry fee.

Selected participants notified of exhibit inclusion and area of display
Show open to the public in Gallery One at the Everhart Museum.

A panel of museum staff and community partners will judge the show and select the work for display in Gallery One.
