Destinations in Paintings: The Kasten Collection, area residents are invited to capture locations inspired by their secret knowledge of northeastern PA. Partnering with the Lackawanna Heritage Valley (LHV), the Everhart nurtures creativity and showcases artistic excellence in the community.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all residents in Northeastern Pennsylvania.

DIRECTIVE:

Create an artwork that illustrates a secret or hidden space in Scranton or Northeastern Pennsylvania that only you or your friends might know about. Originality is key, so please be creative!

ENTRY RULES:

- 1) Work will only be accepted in the following media: photography or mixed media (2-D). No videos, 3-D work, or installation pieces will be accepted. Each artist will be limited to two submissions.
- 2) Entry dimensions must be no greater than 11" x 14" and must be UN-framed and UN-matted. Entries will also be considered digitally, 8x10" image at 300 dpi to be emailed to the curator at the email address below. The Everhart Museum will then print the selected images for exhibition.
- 3) Only original work will be shown. No reproductions will be accepted. Works will not be for sale.
- 4) COMPLETE entry form/ID tag must be submitted attached to the reverse of each original piece or along with the digital entry. Work submitted without a complete entry form will not be considered for exhibition.
- 5) All pieces must be submitted to the Everhart Museum office, located through the rear entrance of 1901 Mulberry Street, Scranton, PA 18510, between 11 am and 4 pm on 31 October 2014. Work may also be submitted via mail, postmarked by the 31 October deadline.
- 6) All work submitted will be subject to a juried competition for inclusion in the final show. Submitting a work does not guarantee that it will appear in the show.

ENTRY FEE: There is no entry fee.
