

- 9/5** **Everhart Reads Book Club.** Everhart Reads book club has existed for 10+ years and meets once a month to discuss selected books related to museum content. These **FREE** monthly discussions take place on the first Thursday of every month (with the exception of January and July) at the Everhart Museum at 6:00PM. Our September book choice is The Nightingale, by Kristin Hannah.
- 9/5** **Parks & Recreation Meeting.** Open to the public. 6-7pm.
- 9/14** **On & On Charity Auction and 4<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration.** Do you have some treasures in your attic that you've been meaning to donate or sell? Now's your chance to free up some storage space while supporting the Everhart. On&On is looking for donations of vintage, antiques, or art to auction off on the 14. There are two, two-hour sessions which run back-to-back, or you may stay for the entire four hours: 3-5pm, and 5-7pm.
- 9/19** **Volunteer Get-To-Know-You Night.** The Everhart Museum will be hosting a Meet and Greet event as an opportunity for new and returning volunteers to get to know the Museum. During this event, attendees will be provided with a generalized tour of the updated collection, as well as be (re)introduced to the types of volunteer and internship opportunities at the Everhart. Light refreshments will be provided. Opportunities for high school through adult available.
- 9/22** **FREE Museum Day – Smithsonian Year of Music Day.** Each year museums, zoos and cultural institutions offer free admission as a celebration of boundless curiosity hosted by Smithsonian magazine. Participating museums and cultural institutions across the country provide free entry to anyone presenting a Museum Day ticket. The Everhart Museum will be celebrating this year's theme "A Year of Music" with a free drop-in workshop with musician Doug Smith and writer/poet Lucia Dailey. Doug and Lucia will discuss how music and memory are connected through an interactive multi-modal arts experience. Their demonstration will take place in the new exhibit "Another Way of Remembering" works of art by residents of Wesley Village at United Methodist Homes. **The Museum Day ticket provides free admission to the Everhart.**
- 9/26** **Victoria Lowe Show Opening. The Essence of Color: The Art of Victoria Lowe,** September 27 – December 31, 2019. This exhibition explores the abstract paintings by Alabama-based artist Victoria Lowe. Inspired by stargazing and the feeling of sublime connectedness to things beyond the physical environment and conscious comprehension Lowe's painting include abstract fields activated by color.
