Position Title: **Art Educator (contracted, part-time)**

Position Description: The purpose of the position is to offer meaningful work in the field of museum education. The Everhart Museum designs and produces weekend art classes, introducing students to the art-making process and the Everhart's collection. Everhart Juniors is a 7-week advanced museum art course for teens and pre-teens (Grades 5-8). Students learn various art techniques and will have a better understanding of the cultural and historical context of each artwork they view. The Art Educator is responsible for collaborating with the education team to design two 7-week art courses and each lesson's curriculum. Classes will be a hybrid of virtual and on-site learning on Saturdays beginning in February for 1.5 hours. The position requires a basic level of understanding of virtual education. Educators are also responsible for pre-recorded art demonstrations.

Requirements: Prior experience working with children, a kind and gentle demeanor, and lots of energy! A degree in Art Education is preferred.

Work Schedule: We are looking to fill this position immediately, with work expected to start no later than January 4, 2021. This position is contracted for 22 weeks at 8 hours per week, with 1.5 hours dedicated to in-person classes. Hours will include collaborative planning time and program implementation.
