## **Position Description:**

## This position requires:

Prior experience working with children, a kind and gentle demeanor, and lots of energy! Background or training in education, museum education, fine arts, art history, or science is recommended. You must be available for ALL 3 weeks in the summer. Applicants must be 18+ years of age.
